

Professional Committee Work Plan 2009

Mission Statement: To enable nurses to meet the challenges of the knowledge-based society by promoting the development of their knowledge and competences at all stages of their professional career development.

Objectives: To develop high educational standards in nursing and to facilitate the transfer and recognition of qualifications and competencies throughout Europe.

Priorities:

- (1) Implementation Directive 36 & EFN enlargement (OLP 3.1)
- (2) Continuous Professional Development (OLP 3.2)
- (3) EUNetPaS WP 2 'Education & Training' (OLP 1.3)
- (4) Patient Information Directive (OLP 1.4)

Issue Type:

- (4) Watching Brief and Alliance Building

Goals:

- (1) Implementation Directive 36
 - Guide new EU Member States/NNA implementing DIRECTIVE 36;
 - Future EU Member States NNA member of EFN;
 - Implement the EFN Position Statement on Synergies between DIRECTIVE 36, Bologna Process and European Qualifications Framework (NNAs and TAIEX experts);
 - Lobby DG Internal Market Peer on the revision of Directive 36 develop EU Accreditation system for Nursing Education (similar to Peer Review);
 - To achieve equivalent standards of nursing care at EU level.
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - EU Structural funds 'social cohesion' are used for CPD alliance with national and European Patient Organisations (EPF);
 - Nurses play an active role in health promotion and healthy lifestyle (submit EFN/OXHA project in 2009).

(3) EUNetPaS

- EFN/EFN members actively involved in EUNetPaS so that the recommendations of this project reflect nurses' perspective.

(4) Patient Information

- Amend Directive on Patient Information;
- EFN stakeholder in EU platforms on Patient Information: EMEA and European Parliament Joint ageing and health and Consumer Intergroup;
- Build alliance with EPHA taking the lead and alliance with BEUC.

Measurement:

- (1) Implementation DIR 36
 - Future Member States NNA member of EFN;
 - All EU Member States comply with Directive 36;
 - DIR 36 safeguarded;
 - Accreditation systems for Nursing Education.
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - Some EFN members, together with patient organisations apply for Structural Funds;
 - EFN members share their experience and exchange applications;
 - New Member States to participate in EFN/OXHA project.
- (3) EU Patient Safety Project EUNetPaS
 - Fulfil work package project obligations.
- (4) Patient Information
 - DG Sanco lead Patient Information;
 - EPHA leads Political debate taking into account EFN members' views.

Timeline:

- (1) Implementation DIRECTIVE 36
 - Croatia implement Acquis Communautaire (DIR 36) end 2009 join EU January 2010;
 - DG Internal Market Directive 36 Report 2012 starting 2009 make proposal for EU Accreditation System;
 - Follow-Up Bologna Ministerial Summit in Belgium (2009).
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - Some EFN members apply for Structural Funds in 2009 together with Patient organisations;
 - New Member States to participate in project EFN/OXHA.
- (3) EUNetPaS
 - Two coordination meetings and three work package meetings planned in 2009.
- (4) Patient Information
 - EPHA leading on patient information EFN input to EPHA 4x/year;
 - EFN member of DG Sanco High Level Group on Professional mobility and Patient Safety – 4x/year;
 - EFN member of the EMEA working group on Health Professionals 2x/year.

Tactics:

- (1) Implementation Directive 36
 - Future Member States NNA pro-actively involved in EFN
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - Alliance building with EPF
- (3) EUNetPaS
 - Alliance building CPME, HOPE, PGEU, EPF

(4) Patient Information

- Alliance building with EPHA and BEUC

Actions:

- (1) Implementation Directive 36
 - Contact future Member States NNA develop strategy and visit EFN members who are not participating anymore in GAs (Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary);
 - EFN members' experts to assist DG Internal Market Peer Reviews.
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - Fill in ONE application Form together with EPF;
 - Create list of EFN members and EPF members;
 - EFN-EPF meetings with DG Sanco and DG Region.

(3) EUNetPaS

- Collect requested data and good practices from EFN members;
- Link up with National representatives.
- (4) Patient Information
 - EPHA to organise meeting with MEP Health and Consumer Intergroup on patients mobility;
 - To monitor the progress made in the Pharmaceutical Forum and EMEA actions.

Outcome:

- (1) Implementation Directive 36
 - All EU Member States comply with Directive 36;
 - EFN developed EU Accreditation System for Nursing Education;
 - Future EU Member States NNA member of EFN.
- (2) Continuous Professional Development
 - EFN members funded through Structural Funds to build capacity;
 - Nurses taking the lead in Health Promotion.
- (3) EU Patient Safety Project
 - EUNetPaS outcomes incorporate EFN members input and vision.
- (4) Patient Information
 - DG Sanco lead;
 - Directive complies with EFN position on Informed Patient.
